**A maximum of 80 semester credit hours from a two-year institution may be applied to a baccalaureate degree at Texas Tech.**

**Note while attending Lee College:**

- Applicable hours:** A minimum of 51 of the above 60 hours will apply to the Applied Arts and Sciences (BAAS) degree at Texas Tech.
- BAAS Advising:** Students must be advised by the Texas Tech B.A.A.S advisor BEFORE STARTING the program at the university.
- Foreign Language Requirement:** a) Students must send an official high school transcript documenting two years of a single foreign language earned in high school, b) send an official college transcript documenting two semesters of a single foreign language from another college, OR c) complete two semesters (or the equivalent) of a single foreign language at the first-year level at Texas Tech.

**General Information: Bachelor of Applied Arts and Sciences in Applied Arts and Sciences at Texas Tech**

This degree program allows students who have earned an Associate of Applied Arts or Sciences from a two-year institution to complete a Bachelor of Applied Arts and Sciences in Applied Arts and Sciences. The degree is NOT open to Texas Tech students seeking to change their major. Special Admission Requirements for Applied Arts and Sciences (BAAS) Major Specific:

- BAAS Advising:** Students must be advised by the Texas Tech B.A.A.S advisor one semester BEFORE STARTING the program at the university.
- AAS Degree:** Students must earn an applied associate's degree from an approved institution BEFORE being admitted to TTU.
- A committee in the University Studies department at TTU will determine the applicability of the student's A.A.S. degree upon admission.

**Degree Requirements**

**Hours required:** a minimum of 120 semester hours, 40 of which must be at the 3000/4000 level, and fulfillment of all degree requirements for the Bachelor of Applied Arts and Sciences degree as specified in the "General Requirements" in the Academic Requirements section of the TTU 2024-2025 catalog.

**Major Requirements:**

- Occupational Specialization, up to 36 hours.

Comprised of courses related to a specific occupation, field, or subject. The occupational concentration typically consists of field-specific coursework completed for an Associate of Science (A.S.) degree at a community college. Active-duty military or veteran students might receive credit for technical or other formal training courses under this component of the degree plan. Students need to provide a DD214 to the B.A.A.S advisor for consultation regarding academic credit to apply toward the degree.

2. Professional Development Concentrations, 36 hours.

Consists of two separate concentrations that serve to enhance the skills acquired by the student through an applied associate's degree or are complimentary themes of interest. Requires completion of 36 hours in two separate concentrations of 18 hours each.

Concentration 1 (Area 1): 18 semester credit hours of Human Resource Development concentration.

Concentration 2 (Area 2): 18 semester credit hours of Organizational Leadership or General Business concentration.

- State of Texas Core Curriculum: students are required to complete the core curriculum for the bachelor degree. Core courses completed and transferred to the university will be applied to the degree. Any remaining core areas not completed at the time of transfer will need to be completed in consultation with the TTU B.A.A.S advisor.
