

Opt Out of Emergency Alerts

Emergency Alerts Notification Process

Lee College uses Omnilert to provide notifications in an emergency or urgent situation that poses a safety risk to the campus community or unexpected occurrences that may affect the delivery of services, such as power outages.

Notifications are provided via text, email, the Lee College website, social media, and local news broadcasts.

Students and employees are automatically enrolled in the system, and messages are sent to your Lee College email address and mobile phone number.

OPTING OUT of Navigator Alerts Emergency Notification

To stop or unsubscribe from receiving text message alerts, you can reply to the last Navigator Alerts text message with the word STOP. You will stop receiving text message alerts, but you will still receive email alerts.

To opt out of Navigator Alerts entirely and stop receiving emergency text messages and emails, download the [Opt-Out Form \(PDF\)](#) and submit the form to navigationalerts@lee.edu.
