

Dependent Appeal Review of Extenuating Circumstances

The Federal methodology assumes that the primary responsibility for paying for college cost rest with the family. Federal regulations permit the college to exercise professional judgment in determining if unusual circumstances can be documented to make the student independent for federal financial aid purposes. On a case-by-case basis, the Office of student financial aid will exercise professional judgment in determining if unusual circumstances exist and if adequate documentation has been provided.

WHAT DOES NOT CONSTITUTE EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES?

Please Read Carefully!

You cannot file an appeal if your circumstances represent any of the categories listed below.

- 1. A parent is refusing to provide information or contribute to your education.
- 2. A student who does not want to ask parents for information.
- 3. A student who is and has been on "their own" for several years.
- 4. Parents who do not claim the student as a dependent for income tax purposes.
- 5. A student who has been previously considered independent of receiving financial aid.
- 6. A student who is divorced when filing a FAFSA and does not meet one of the current definitions of independence for 2025-2026.

Complete the Dependent Appeal and attach documentation to the appeal. Circumstances must be validated through documentation. Failure to provide adequate documentation will result in the request being denied.

Retain this instruction sheet and keep copies of your documents for your records. The Office cannot return documents or provide copies at a later date. Place your Lee College ID Number on all documents.
