Important Information

Graduation Regalia

Graduates are required to wear a black cap and gown for the commencement ceremony. Graduates may opt to wear a Lee College stole but it is not required. You may purchase your graduation regalia through Jostens online <https://www.jostens.com/apps/store/customer/1431082/Lee-College/>, it will be shipped directly to your address. Order early to ensure your regalia will arrive in time; please note the order deadlines displayed on the Jostens website and in the instructions emailed to graduates. Regalia is not sold on campus. **The deadline to purchase a Lee College Proud Navigator or First Generation stole is April 4; the deadline to purchase your cap and gown is April 18. Jostens will ship the regalia directly to your address.**

Bags will not be allowed on stage; please bring only essential items to the graduation ceremony or leave personal belongings with your guests. If it is larger than a cell phone and cannot fit in your pocket, it will not be allowed on stage.

Guests

Tickets are not required for guests to attend the ceremony. We ask that graduates limit the number of invited guests to a **maximum of nine**. Seating for guests is on a first-come, first-served basis, and there are no assigned or reserved seats. Because of space limitations, if we reach capacity limits in the Performing Arts Center, guests will be redirected to view the streaming ceremony in Nursing lecture hall, Room S01, in the McNulty-Haddick building ([map](#)).
