What will I learn?

- ED25 AAT Prepares potential teachers for early childhood to sixth grade, as a Generalist, Bilingual Generalist, ESL Generalist, or Special Education Generalist.
- ED35 AAT Future teachers interested in 4th to 8th-grade teaching.
- ED45 AAT Students interested in pursuing an area of specialization applied to early childhood through grade 12 (Music, Physical Education, Art, etc.) or grades 8 through 12 (Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Business, Languages, etc.).

What can I do with this course of study?

Course

The AAT degree is designed for transfer purposes. Some students decide to stop out after completing the degree. The AAT meets the educational requirements for educational aides and substitute teachers. In addition, completion of the AAT is much like that of an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree in that it may qualify students for work that minimally require an associate degree.
